Notes that postmark was used from 23 June 1899 to 4 February 1901 and that cancel is more often found in purple than in black. Refers personal communication with Don Peterson indicating that there were several circumstances that allowed Spanish Philippine stamps (mostly the 1898 issues) to have been cancelled with U.S. military postal station postmarks: Bags of Undelivered Mail, Short-Term Continued Use of Spanish Philippine (1898) Issues at U.S. Occupied P.O.s, and Philatelic Usage added as "decoration" onto outbound foreign mail.

The covers use the various titles although the first page of the catalogue is typically titled "Priced catalogue of English, foreign and colonial postage stamps". Some editions exist advertised as 'Album and Caralogue' which include ruled pages inserted between the catalogue pages to allow stamps to be affixed

Transcript of paper read before the Philatelic Society London, on 10th January 1896, by M. P. Castle (Castle 1896). The paper notes the Philippines in the list of countries whose stamps are mainly rare (unused or used) suggesting that they are not recommended for any but the most advance Philatelic student, or the wealthiest class of collectors.

The only criticism of this work is that, apart from the first fifty copies, the plates of the 1854 issues will be absent noting that the first issue is held of greatest importance to collectors and has in effect placed the Philippines upon a high plane along with other "classics". Similarly, the review notes that only three lines are devoted to a description of the stamps, and nine or ten to cataloguing the colours of the four values and that discussion on the question of re-engraving the 5-cuartos, the possible re-engraving of the 1 real and other details are entirely absent.

Loney, Nicolas.

Nicolas Loney was the British Vice Consul to Iloilo. The letter includes a description of the current mail route via Hong Kong and advocates for a route via Singapore, and also advocates for the establishment of an inter-island telegraphic communication system and mentions a sketch of a telegraphic map for the island of Luzon and the Southern islands which he has prepared with Sir Charles Bright.

Lopez, Leopoldo.

[Lopez, L. \(1878\)](#). **Le timbre 3 cuartos Don Carlos**. Le Timbre-Poste, vol 16 no 186, pp. 47-48.

A letter to Mr J.B. Moens, the main part of the letter responds to earlier discussions regarding whether the 3c stamp of Don Carlos is genuine or fake. The letter includes mention that philately in Spain is in its infancy and mentions the intelligence and efforts of Mr Moens; but notes that the author does not believe him to be the 'greatest and infallible philatelic oracle' as demonstrated by a multitude of errors in the last edition of his catalogue in what relates to the stamps of Cuba, Puerto Rico and the Philippines, to the extreme of not knowing anything about it.

The editor responds that the mentioned catalogue contains the same errors that exist elsewhere because there has been no responses from Spain for requests for information, and asks the author to provide specific details of the error and to provide a complete and exact history of the countries mentioned.

This is the first edition. The subtitle notes that the catalogue is organised in accordance with the Historical-Descriptive Report and published by Royal Decree and under the direction of Antonio Fernandez Duro and perhaps continues on from [Fernandez 1881](#).

The catalogue includes prices at which stamps could be purchased from the philatelic establishment of Leopoldo Lopez, Madrid. There is a statement in the catalogue that it was awarded a silver medal at the Philippines Exhibition of 1887 suggesting the author may have published it as an offprint and later, in 1888, as a catalogue.

The second edition was published as [Lopez \(1890\)](#).

Unidentified acronym of an author in The Weekly Philatelic Era.

[M.A.K. \(1903\)](#). **A comparison of prices**. The Weekly Philatelic Era, vol 18 no 14, p115. (WN 554, 26 December 1903).

Review of “*Catalogue des Timbres Rares et Moyens*” publ A La Fare, Paris. This catalogue compares prices of stamps as quoted in the standard catalogues. The catalogue also includes latest transactions, reportedly reflecting the latest selling prices. Mentions the 1854 1r blue “CORROS” error and compares the price with one sold in Boston a short time ago. Also mentions Scott #173c and suggest the prices quoted by Senf are those for a dangerous forgery emanating from Barcelona.

“MANILA”.

Unidentified pseudonym of a correspondent with the Royal Philatelic Society in *The Philatelic Record*, probably based in the Philippines. One article refers to a Mr Campbell, although it is not clear whether this is referring to “MANILA”

McGee, J. F.

[McGee, J. \(1938\)](#). **The Spanish ‘Zamboanga’ Philippine issue**. Weekly Philatelic Gossip, pp. 653-654. (22 January 1938).

Discusses reasoning for the need of stamps used by Spanish postal service in those areas of the Philippines used as a base for the departing Spanish military which took place for nearly a year after the loss of Manila. Provides a list of stamps known to be surcharged and a note that blue overprints are believed to be forgeries.

[McGee, J. \(1942\)](#). **Philippine Islands, Spanish ‘Zamboanga’ issues**. Stamps, vol 38 no 6, pp. 200-201. (WN 491, 7 February 1942).

Comments that after the fall of Manila, Spain demonetised all of the Philippine stamps but validated for further service with the use of a surcharge the 1898 issue in order to use the stamps in those parts of the island which Spain still held.

McKearin, George S.

[McKearin, G. \(1900\)](#). **Noted by the way**. The Weekly Philatelic Era, vol 15 no 2, p18. (WN 386, 6 October 1900).

Report of 1879 issue in which the “S” of “Correos” in the surcharge is missing. Also report that 1r on 5c blue comes in a decided yellow green and in a blue green also.

Mackay, James Alexander.

[Mackay, J. \(1967\)](#). **The Tapling Collection**. Gibbons Stamp Monthly, vol 40 no 5, pp. 84-85. (January 1967).

Notes of the Tapling collection recording that the Philippine Islands forms plates 691 to 704 with partially constructed plates of the 1854 issues followed with Cuban stamps used in the Philippines. The Habilitado overprints are well represented, and the section concludes with a newspaper wrapper and a cover bearing examples of American stamps with “Military Sta No 1” c.d.s during the Spanish-American War of 1898.

[Mackay, J. \(1972\)](#). **The World of classic stamps**. 334pp. (pp. 180, 182-183, 187, 317) publ. G.P. Putnam’s Sons, New York.

Chapter 5 describes the development of the postage stamp from the 1850s and includes descriptions and illustrations of the early Philippine issues, noting that the stamps were the first to be produced in Asia and generally represent unflattering profiles of Queen Isabella. A list of typical prices is provided.

Under ‘unusual types of paper used in production’, records the 1859 5c cuartos issue as being printed on ribbed paper with corrugations on one side.

First edition published in 1982, with a second edition in 1988 (reprinted in 1992).

Study of the Spanish babyhead 15c issue and the shade variety/colour error of this issue. Philatelic details of the issue are described, which mention the presence of 9 engraved secret marks in order to avoid postal counterfeit. Analysis of inks and paper. Paper was identified to be cellulose, probably using mixtures of pine fibre and eucalyptus. Interesting background information to the Spanish-Philippine stamps of this period.

Madrid Filatelico

The Madrid Filatelico was first published in 1897 by Miguel Galvez a well-known stamp dealer and later by his son Manuel Galvez

In the main, publication has continued through to 2009 (editions were ceased in 1903 and May to Dec 1914, and again between 1936 and 1946).

The editor of the early editions was Miguel Alena, a brother-in-law of Miguel Galvez.

The 1897-1899 editions are available in the British Library and the US Postal Museum Library.

Report examples seen are all mint but comment that it was in circulation for a very few days and therefore used copies are scarce.

It was reportedly purchased by Galvez in 1918 for over 500,000 pesetas. It appears that a large part of the collection was sold back to Dr Chiesa only keeping back the volume on the Philippines.

Some of the most important pieces from the early Philippines, which include reconstructed and whole plates, the CORROS error, are illustrated in this article.

Magazine of Philately, The

The Magazine of Philately was a monthly magazine first published in May 1883. The magazine was the organ of the Institute of Philatelists, of Liverpool. It was published by The Universal Foreign Stamp Company and the first five issues (up to September 1883) were edited by G. Henry Readdy until his retirement. The subsequent issue comprised numbers 6, 7 and 8 was issued in December 1883 with a new editor, George Birtwhistle and announcement that the magazine now incorporated the Universal Philatelic Magazine. However, this edition appears to have also been the last issue.

Magnus (Dr)

Was a pseudonym used by Dr [Jacques Amable Legrand](#).

Report that reprints exist in the philatelic world. One example provided are the stamps of Luzon from the series referred to as the four types. Report that the 10c is easy to find, but mint examples of the 5c are rare. Notes that Mr Maury recently presented groups of four and Dr Magnus believes that Maury was misled and that the new stamps are distinguishable from the old ones through the design, colour, paper and gum which are described. It is concluded that the stamps are a recent reprint. The account continues with a description of the issue that replaced the 'four type' series, it appears to justify that there were already other stamps available for use.

The article was criticised in the [Timbe-Poste \(1869a\)](#) and the [Stamp-Collector's Magazine \(1869\)](#) and further information was then provided by provided in [Dr Magnus \(1869b\)](#).

Mahe notes that no one had ever before seen the stamps of "Luzon" otherwise than singly, obliterated and generally in very bad condition. Each sheet was sold for the price of 400francs.

The first edition of Kpankla was issued as [Pardo de Figuero \(1870a\)](#). In Kpankla Section 4 (p16) mentions the scarcity and high cost of 1r and 2r issues from 1854 to 1863 and notes that the "CORROS" error cannot be found at any price. Section 8 of Kpankla (p40) provides a table describing the comparative spread of correspondence between 1867 and 1869 in various countries, including the Philippines.

(b. 1844, d.1907). Arthur Maury ran a stamp shop in Paris. He produced a descriptive catalogue of stamps of the world and published the journal [Le Collectionneur de Timbres-Poste](#). A philatelic biography is provided in [The London Philatelist \(1907b\)](#).

More than ten years ago he had moistened it and placed under the press remove the brittle folds. He had assumed it had been stolen. The sheet he then sent to Mr Tapling for 1,800 Francs. In this account about how to handle and mount stamps, an interesting account in itself, and on the subject of whether the gum should be retained on mint stamps, Maury notes that gum can be an agent of alteration and even destruction. In a list of examples, he includes the 1854 issue of the Philippines noting that in many the paper has become dry and brittle. Also listed as [Collectionneur de Timbres-Poste \(1900b\)](#).

Mekeel, C.H.

Charles Meekel was a well-known American stamp dealer and was editor to a number of stamp journals. He published the first edition of his stamp catalogue of the world in 1894.

The first edition of Mekeel's stamp catalogue of the world was published in 1894 and reported to provide a description and illustration of all postage stamps of every government of the world with prices at which they are sold, used and unused. The first edition was priced at \$1, the second edition produced 1 January 1895 was priced 50c. Despite the claim there were no illustrations of the babyhead series, only a catalogue list and prices (mainly for mint).

Mekeel's Weekly Stamp News

Mekeel's Weekly Stamp News was originally established in 1891 by Charles Mekeel Stamp and Publishing Company. In 1897 due to problems of liquidity in the parent company led Charles Mekeel to lease and then sell the title to his brother and the magazine editor Isaac A Mekeel. For a short period between March 1904 and February 1905 it was known as **Mekeel's Weekly Stamp News and The Weekly Philatelic Era**, but then reverted to its original title.

In 1996 when it merged with **Stamps** and became **Mekeel's Weekly and Stamps**. The present-day successor is titled **Mekeel's and Stamps magazine**.

Moens, Jean Baptiste.

(b 27 May 1833 – 28 Apr 1908). Jean-Baptiste Moens was a Belgium philatelist and recognised as one of the first dealers in stamps for collectors. His works are some of the earliest recorded which feature Philippine philately. He began producing manuals and catalogues for postage stamps in 1862. He also began the first French language philatelic monthly magazine, [Le Timbre-Poste](#).
