The **FEPEC Clarion** was a quarterly magazine first published in 1952 by the Far East Exchange Club, Manila. The editor was Phil. Odulio.

Filipinas Filatelico.

The **Filipinas Filatelico** magazine was the first stamp magazine of the Philippines. The first issue was published 30 September 1914; published and edited by Jose E Marco of Pontevedra, Negros Occidental. The magazine was bilingual, English and Spanish. The magazine folded after a short duration.

The **Mayon Stamp Digest** was published between 1938 and 1941 and was the official journal of the Philippine Philatelic Club, Manila; edited by Pat Yapsinco Kelly.

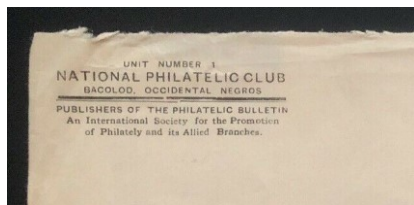
Postage Stamps Digest, The

Revista Filatelica Filipina.

The **Revista Filatelica Filipina** magazine was published between January 1925 and October 1926; published and edited by Joaquin Ortiz in Manila. The magazine was published quarterly in English and Spanish. Ortiz organised the stamp club "Asociacion Filatelia de Filipinas" and the **Revista Filatelica Filipinas** became its official organ. Later the magazine was superseded by the **A.F.F.**
